Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Bannister Creek Primary School students will complete in-term swimming lessons at the Riverton Leisureplex in Term 2. Lessons will take place from **Monday 22 May to Friday 2 June 2023** for the classes detailed in the table below. **Please Note: This is a 10-day program.** Swimming lessons are part of the Bannister Creek PS Health and Physical Education Program for 2023. Every child is encouraged to participate.

PLEASE REMEMBER:

1. **All belongings** (bathers, towels, goggles, thongs/sandals) **must be labelled.**
2. Thongs may be worn to & from the pool, **No bare feet!** Children must change into sneakers for school times.
3. Children are not to wear expensive sneakers/shoes or jewellery (including watches) to the pool.
4. **Children with uncovered planter warts will be excluded from the pool.**

The children will shower off at the pool and then change into uniform on their return to School. Children may wear their bathers under their uniform to school. Please provide a plastic bag for wet bathers & towels.

SWIMMING & WATER SAFETY:

Please note the following information/requirement as received from Swimming & Water Safety Section:

Medical advice has been received on essential precautions to be taken in connection with children whose medical conditions could put them at risk in the water.

If a child has been observed or is otherwise known to be subject to any form of medical condition involving periodic loss of consciousness, the child should not be permitted to swim, unless a medical certificate is produced by the child's parents stating that it is safe for the child to participate, *or additional supervision can be arranged making it safe for the child.*

Medical certificates should be available on day 1 of lessons and are usually valid for 12 months or less if a further episode occurs. Any requirement for additional supervision should be arranged by the parent prior to the commencement of lessons. In such cases, the parent must be satisfied with the level of supervision and accept complete responsibility.

COST: \$53.80 per child (Bus fare and pool entry, lessons are free).

Please return the permission form and any cash payments to the Front Office in a sealed envelope. Please print your child's name and room number clearly.

- Payment can be made in two instalments, with full payment required before the first lesson. Please make arrangements at the Front Office.
- There is no guarantee of a refund for missed lessons.
